Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the funds allocated, released and expended by Assam under the National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM) during the last ten years;**
- (b) the number of Institutions of the Poor (IoP) recognised in Assam under the NRLM, districtwise;**
- (c) the details and the number of IoPs that specifically cater to the female tribal population in Assam, year-wise; and**
- (d) the number of individuals who have been trained under the NRLM's Aajeevika Skills Development Programme in Assam during the said period?**

(a): The details of the funds allocated, released and expended by Assam under the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana- National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM) are given at Annexure-I.

(b): Under the National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM), Institutions of the Poor (IoP) are formed which are called as Self-Help Groups (SHGs). District-wise number of SHGs promoted in Assam under the DAY-NRLM are given at Annexure-II.

(c): The district-wise details of number of SHGs promoted under DAY-NRLM belonging to Scheduled Tribes (STs) in Assam are given at Annexure-III.

(d): There is no such scheme named as “Aajeevika Skills Development Programme” under the DAY-NRLM. However, during the last ten years, in Assam under the sub-schemes of DAY-NRLM DeenDayalUpadhyaya - GrameenKaushalyaYojana (DDU-GKY), a total of 79,164 number of individuals have been trained, while under Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETI) a total of 131049 individuals have been trained.
