Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of households identified and included in the DeendayalAntyodayaYojana -National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM) target group particularly in Pali district ofRajasthan;
- (b) the total amount of Vulnerability Reduction Fund (VRF) disbursed to Village Organizations Rajasthan during each of the last three financial years especially in Pali district; and
- (c) whether any special projects have been sanctioned for particularly vulnerable communities in Rajasthan under DAY-NRLM, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (DR. CHANDRA SEKHAR PEMMASANI)

- (a): Under DeendayalAntodayaYojana National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM 10.05 crore rural poor households have been mobilised into 90.86 Lakh Self Help Groups (SHGs). In the State of Rajasthan, 38.04 Lakh households have been mobilised into 3.21 lakh SHGs. Further, in Pali district of Rajasthan, a total number of 1,11,308 households have been identified and included under the DAY-NRLM.
- (b): An amount of Rs. 62,50,000 has been disbursed to Village Organizations (VOs) in Rajasthan during the last three financial years. An amount of Rs. 12,50,000 has been disbursed in Pali district of Rajasthan. The details of funds disbursed under Vulnerability Reduction Fund (VRF) are given at Annexure-I and Annexure-II.

(c): Yes, a project titled 'UPARJAN' has been sanctioned on 01.10.2023 for particularly vulnerable communities in Rajasthan under DAY-NRLM. The project has been undertaken as an innovative activity under the DAY-NRLM programme. The target groups for the project are mainly multi-dimensionally poor households from Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs), Scheduled Tribes (STs) and Scheduled Castes (SCs). The project covers 4000 households and is being implemented in 4 blocks across 3 districts of Rajasthan – Todabhim block (Karauli District), Kishanganj block (Baran District), Shahbad block (Baran District) and Pindwara block (Sirohi District).
