**SCHEMES IN CHHATTISGARH**

**2380 SHRI BRIJMOHAN AGRAWAL:**

**Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) the names of various districts in Chhattisgarh where the Government run Central Schemes including Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS), Self Employment Scheme, Skill Development Scheme, National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP), Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY), Integrated Watershed Management Programme (IWMP), Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) and National Rural Livelihood Mission etc. are being implemented;**
- (b) the amount of funds allocated to Chhattisgarh by the Union Government for the said Scheme during each of the last five years, district-wise;**
- (c) the number of beneficiaries from Chhattisgarh who have been extended benefits of the said Schemes;**
- (d) the year and district-wise number of beneficiaries awaiting benefits under the said Schemes; and**
- (e) the action being taken to ensure that these awaiting persons receive benefits under the said Schemes?**

**ANSWER**

**MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT  
(SHRI KAMLESH PASWAN)**

**(a): Ministry of Rural Development is implementing a number of schemes for the development of rural areas of the country including the state of Chhattisgarh viz., Mahatma Gandhi National Rural**

**Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS), Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana – Gramin (PMAY-G), Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM), Deen Dayal Upadhyay – Gramin Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETIs) and National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP) and Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY). The Integrated Watershed Management Programme (IWMP) for development of rainfed and degraded areas, implemented since 2009-10 was amalgamated as a Watershed Development Component (WDC) of the Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (WDC-PMKSY) in 2015-16.**

**MGNREGA, PMAY-G, PMGSY, DAY-NRLM and NSAP schemes are implemented in all districts of Chhattishgarh. DDU-GKY is implemented at the State Level and there is no provision of its implementation at the district level. However, the districts of Chhattishgarh in which RSETIs, SAGY and WDC-PMKSY are implemented are at Annexure-I.**

**(b): Funds under these schemes are allocated by this Ministry to the States/UTs including Chhattishgarh which in turn release to the concerned districts. Hence, this Ministry does not allocate/release funds to the districts. In addition to this, SAGY is a 100% convergence-based scheme without allocation of any funds from Ministry of Rural Development for projects undertaken under the scheme. Resources for SAGY projects are mobilized from other schemes of the Central Government and States, Corporate Social Responsibility funds from the corporate sector, and contribution of voluntary, private organisations.**

**The total allocation of funds under the other schemes of this Ministry to Chhattisgarh from the Financial Year 2019-20 to 2023-24 are as per Annexure-II.**

**(c) to (e): The details of beneficiaries from Chhattisgarh under the above-mentioned schemes are as under:**

**(i) MGNREGA:- It is a demand driven wage employment programme and benefits are provided to the beneficiaries as per their demand. Details of the person days generated in the State of Chattisgarh under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS for the last five financial years from 2019-20 to 2023-24 are given as under:**

**(ii) PMAY-G: Under PMAY-G, the State Govt. of Chhattisgarh was allocated a total target of 11,76,142 houses out of which 11,76,141 houses have been sanctioned and 10,89,331 houses have been completed as on date. Further, the Central Govt has announced in the Budget FY 2024-25 for construction of 2 crore additional houses in next five years i.e. 2024-25 to 2028-29 under the PMAY-G to meet the requirements arising housing needs in rural areas from increase in the number of households.**

**(iii) PMGSY: Since the inception of the scheme till 01.08.2024, a total of 47,202 km of road length has been sanctioned, out of which 42,567 Km of road length has been completed with an expenditure of Rs.16,596.51 crore in the State of Chhattisgarh under various interventions/verticals of PMGSY. Further, PMGSY is an area development programme and not an individual or community beneficiary scheme. The unit of connectivity under this scheme is habitation and the objective of the scheme is to provide all-weather road connectivity in rural areas catering to the access needs of the entire population of the target habitation.**

**(iv) DAY-NRLM: - A total of 2,77,345 Self Help Groups and 29,22,118 House Holds have benefited through National Rural Livelihood Mission in Chhattisgarh till date. Under the NRLM programme, community strengthening and building strong institutions for them is a continuous process which is undertaken based on felt needs of the community. The programme is designed based on past experience especially to address these diverse needs of rural communities. By focusing on capacity building of SHG women, providing them financial inclusion, market access, and community empowerment, it aims to create sustainable livelihoods that contribute to overall rural development and poverty alleviation.**

**(v) DDU-GKY & RSETIs: The details of candidates trained, placed and settled under DDU-GKY and RSETIs are as under:**

**(vi) NSAP: Under NSAP schemes, State/UT-wise ceiling of beneficiaries (state cap) and budget outlay have already been approved for 15th Finance Cycle. A total of 3.09 crore beneficiaries are covered for benefits under NSAP schemes as per the last revision held in 2022. However, if there are more deserving beneficiaries, the States/UTs have the option to give them pension from their own resources. The number of beneficiaries during last 5 years under NSAP schemes in Chhattishgarh is as under:**

**(vii) WDC-PMKSY: It is an area development programme wherein all the people of the project are benefitted through the interventions undertaken under the programme. However, as per information received from the State, under WDC-PMKSY 2.0, approximately 8,362 number of farmers benefitted and 11,38,597 number of man-days generated.**
