2496. SHRI SANJAY UTTAMRAO DESHMUKH:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to increase the Minimum Support Prices (MSP) for Soyabean as the MSP provided at present is very low and affects the economic condition of the farmers of Washim area in the State of Maharashtra where the said crop is produced at a larger scale; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): Government fixes Minimum Support Prices (MSPs) for 22 mandated agricultural crops including Soyabean on the basis of the recommendations of the Commission for Agricultural Costs & Prices (CACP) and in consultation with State Governments and a stake holder Central Ministries / Departments. While recommending MSP, CACP considers important factors like cost of production, overall demand-supply conditions, domestic and international prices, intercrop price parity, terms of trade between agricultural and non-agricultural sectors, likely effect on the rest of the economy, besides ensuring rational utilization of land, water and other production resources and a minimum of 50 percent as the margin over cost of production. The details of MSPs for Soyabean during last 5 years are given below.
