(a) & (b): Government has approved Vibrant Villages Programme (VVP) as a

Centrally Sponsored Scheme on 15th February, 2023, with financial outlay of

₹4800 crore for the FY 2022-23 to 2025-26, for comprehensive development

of select villages in 46 blocks abutting northern border in 19 districts in the

States of Arunachal Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Sikkim, Uttarakhand and

UT of Ladakh. The VVP is reviewed regularly with all stakeholders including

States/UT and Central Ministries/Departments for its effective

implementation.

(c): Under Vibrant Villages Programme, 6045 activities (3451 in 2023 and 2594 activities in 2024 till 31.07.2024) across Vibrant Villages have been conducted since inception including awareness drive, service delivery camps, training and capacity building activities, health and veterinary camps, fair & festivals and promotion of tourism activities, etc.
