- (a) whether the Government is aware of the components of the National Knowledge Network; and
- (b) if so, details thereof along with the number of institutions benefiting from the Network?

ANSWER

(a) and (b): National Knowledge Network ('NKN') carries the digital-traffic of National/state Data Centres (NDCs/SDCs), State-Wide Area Networks (SWANs) and provides connectivity to various Digital India initiatives. It also carries digital-traffic of various G2G (Government to Government) and G2C (Government to Citizen) services. NKN also inter-connects all knowledge institutions across the country through high-speed data communication network to encourage sharing of resources and collaborative research. By June, 2024, 1,802 links to institutions had been commissioned and made operational under NKN.
