Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:

- (a) the details and the criteria for funding support to eligible startups and MSMEs to promote research & innovation under the Aatmanirbhar Bharat ARISE-ANIC;
- (b) the number of proposals received by the Government under the Aatmanirbhar Bharat ARISE-ANIC programme during the last five years, State-wise, particularly in Maharashtra;
- (c) the details of applications received from the Sangli Parliamentary Constituency of Maharashtra along with the steps taken by the Government thereon; and
- (d) the funds sanctioned and utilised by the Government under the said programme, particularly in Maharashtra?

(a) ARISE-ANIC program follows a competitive process for selection of start-ups / MSMEs.

Eligible start-ups / MSMEs undergo 3 rounds of evaluation, as under:

1st round:

- each submitted application is evaluated by a set of 3 different assessors
- based on the 1st round evaluation, the scores are standardized and a shortlist is released

2nd round:

- shortlisted applicants from the 1st round undergo an in-person presentation and interview to the Screening-cum-Selection Committee (SSC)
- based on the 2nd round evaluation, SSC recommends a selection list

3rd round:

- selected applicants from the 2nd round undergo budget and goals & deliverables evaluation by the Working Committee (WC)
 based on the 3rd round evaluation, the WC approves the final selection list along with
- based on the 3rd round evaluation, the WC approves the final selection list along with approved Grant for each selected start-up / MSME

The evaluation metrics for selection of start-ups / MSMEs:

Sl. No.	Parameter	Description
1	Relevance	whether the stated solution / innovation is relevant to the selected challenge theme
2	Innovativeness	whether the stated solution / innovation is novel and has IP potential
3	Feasibility	whether the stated solution / innovation is practical and feasible (technically and financially) to deploy
4	Impact	whether the stated solution / innovation can create large-scale impact (economic / social / environmental)
5	Commercialization Potential	whether the stated solution / innovation has a proper business plan / commercialization potential

(b) Under Atmanirbhar Bharat ARISE-ANIC program, 174 applications have been received, out of which 30 applications have been received from Maharashtra. The state wise distribution of application is as below:

- (c) Under ARISE-ANIC program, no application has been received from the Sangli Parliamentary Constituency of Maharashtra.
- (d) ARISE-ANIC provides Grant of up to INR 50 lakhs based on successful achievement of milestones.

Under ARISE-ANIC, 23 start-ups / MSMEs have been selected for Grant funding. 23 start-ups / MSMEs have been approved of Grant of INR 10,69,72,000/-, of which INR 5,92,26,000/- have been disbursed based on successful achievement of milestones.

Under ARISE-ANIC, 8 start-ups / MSMEs selected for Grant funding are from Maharashtra. 8 start-ups / MSMEs from Maharashtra have been approved of Grant of INR 3,70,58,000/- of which INR 2,01,13,000/- have been disbursed based on successful achievement of milestones.
