Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of projects funded under the Aspirational Districts Programme (ADP) in Vizianagaram district, including specific sectors and initiatives undertaken during the last five years;
- (b) the total funds allocated and disbursed for these projects in Vizianagaram district, during the said period, year-wise;
- (c) the current status and progress of these projects in Vizianagaram district, including any completed, ongoing, or planned activities;
- (d) the details of challenges or delays encountered in the implementation of these projects in Vizianagaram district along with the reasons therefor;
- (e) the expected timelines for the completion of ongoing projects in Vizianagaram district and the details of factors that might influence these timelines;
- (f) whether there are any additional proposals for projects under the Aspirational Districts Programme in Vizianagaram district that are under consideration or have been approved recently; and
- (g) if so, the details thereof?

(a), (b) and (c) The details of projects funded under the ADP in Vizianagaram district, including sectors, year-wise funds sanctioned, current status and progress, are attached as Annexure I.

- (d) and (e) As per the Programme guidelines, projects envisaged under the ADP are to be of short duration, preferably to be completed within a year and extendable up to two years. Most of the projects sanctioned to Vizianagaram have been completed (as detailed in Annexure I), and the one remaining is also nearing completion.
- (f) and (g) Vizianagaram was bifurcated into two districts (Vizianagaram and Parvathipuram Manyam) as part of the reorganisation of districts in the State of Andhra Pradesh in 2022. Following this, as per the communication received from the State Government in July 2022, Parvathipuram Manyam was included under the ADP, replacing Vizianagaram. As Vizianagaram is no longer part of the ADP, no additional projects are being considered for the district under the programme.
