- (a) whether the Government proposes to revise the time-table of Ambikapur-Durg Passenger train-18242 so as to reach Raipur Junction at 07.00 am in order to link/connect with the North-south journey trains as well as flights, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to run Sampark Kranti Durg-Harzrat Nizammudin on daily basis which currently runs on Monday, Thursday and Saturday;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to change the name of Ambikapur Hazrat Nizammudin Superfast 22408 to Surguja Superfast express; and
- (d) whether the Government proposes to increase its frequency from once a week to two days from Ambikapur and two days from Hazrat Nizammudin, Delhi?
