Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that bridge at railway level crossing No.265 on Jhunjhunu-Sikar stall highway No.8 is being constructed with the joint efforts of State Government and Railways;
- (b) whether the construction work of the said bridge has been discontinued due to unavailability of Railways share of funds, if so, since when the work has been stopped;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to resume this work by releasing share;
- (d) if so, the time by which it is likely to be resumed; and
- (e) if not, the reasons and the details thereof?

(a) to (e): The work of construction of two lane Road Over Bridge (ROB) in lieu of level crossing (LC) No. 265 on Sikar-Loharu section in 2016-17was sanctioned on cost sharing basis.

The work is being executed by Govt. of Rajasthan on single entity basis. The funds commensurate with the progress of work have been released by Railways.

During 2020-21, State Govt. of Rajasthan desired to construct 04 lane ROB instead of 02 lane ROB. Revised estimate for 04 lane ROB is under preparation by State Govt.
