**COTTAGE INDUSTRIES IN RAJASTHAN**

2768. SHRI RAJKUMAR ROAT:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of cottage industries set up in Rajasthan and employment generated therefrom particularly in Banswara Parliamentary Constituency during the last five years;
- (b) the details of funds allocated during the said period, district and year-wise; and
- (c) whether the Government proposes to promote cottage industries in the scheduled areas and if so, the details thereof, year-wise?

**ANSWER**

(a) and (b): Government implements various schemes to promote cottage industries across the country. These include Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI), Khadi Vikas Yojana (KVY), Gramodyog Vikas Yojana (GVY), etc. The focus of PMEGP is exclusively on employment generation by setting up of new micro enterprises.

The details regarding the number of enterprises, including cottage industries set up in Rajasthan and employment generated there from, district and year-wise, during the last five years is **annexed**.

(c): To encourage micro enterprises including cottage industries and to create employment opportunities for locals, the Government under PMEGP assists General Category beneficiaries with Margin Money (MM) subsidy of 25% of the project cost in rural areas and 15% in urban areas. For beneficiaries belonging to Special Categories such as **Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, OBCs, Minorities, Women, Ex-servicemen, Differently-abled, Transgenders**, beneficiaries belonging to Northeastern Region, Hill and Border areas, and Aspirational Districts, the Margin Money subsidy is 35% in rural areas and 25% in urban area. The maximum cost of project is Rs. 50 lakhs in the manufacturing sector and Rs. 20 lakhs in the service sector.

## 2. SFURTI in Rajasthan:

Total 34 clusters have been approved in the state of Rajasthan under SFURTI with GoI assistance of Rs. 92.33 cr.
