#### DEVELOPMENT OF FOOD PROCESSING SECTOR

Will the Minister of *FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES* be pleased to state;

- (a) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government for the development of food processing sector in the States of Bihar and Jharkhand and Karbi Anglong and Dima Hasao districts in Assam;
- (b) the name of places where Food Processing Parks are being set up by the Government in the State of Bihar along with the current status thereof;
- (c) the number of the said parks set up across the country during the last five years, State and year-wise;
- (d) the details of the specific projects approved to accelerate the growth and scale of small sized business in Jharkhand during the last three years;
- (e) the details of Food Processing Units (FPUs) presently functional across the country, Statewise, particularly in Jharkhand and Bihar; and
- (f) whether the Government proposes to set up multiple FPUs and has formulated any long term scheme for rural areas of Jharkhand and Bihar, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

#### ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI RAVNEET SINGH)

(a): In order to ensure overall development of Food Processing Industries, Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI) has been incentivizing setting up/expansion of related infrastructure through its Central Sector Scheme Pradhan Mantri Kisan SAMPADA Yojana (PMKSY), Production Linked Incentive Scheme for Food Processing Industry (PLISFPI) and Centrally sponsored PM Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PMFME) scheme across the country including rural areas of Bihar, Jharkahnd, Karbi Anglong and Dima Hasao districts of Assam.

Under component schemes of PMKSY, MoFPI provides mostly credit linked financial assistance (capital subsidy) in the form of grants-in-aid to entrepreneurs with total outlay of Rs.5520 Cr for 15<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission Cycle.

Ministry provides financial, technical and business support for setting up/ upgradation of 2 lakh micro food processing enterprises under PMFME scheme. The scheme is operational for a period of five years from 2020-21 to 2024-25 with an outlay of Rs.10,000 Crore.

PLISFPI is, inter alia, intended to support creation of global food manufacturing champions and support Indian brands of food products in international market. The Scheme is being implemented over a six-year period from 2021-22 to 2026-27 with an outlay of Rs. 10,900 crores.

- **(b):** The details of two Mega Food Park (MFP) projects approved in the State of Bihar is given at **Annexure-I.**
- (c): The details of six MFP projects approved in the country since 2019-20 is given at **Annexure-II**.
- (d): A total of 1823 micro food processing Enterprises have been approved in Jharkhand under PMFME Scheme.
- (e): The number of registered food processing units across the country, including Jharkhand & Bihar, as per Annual Survey of Industries 2021-22, is placed at **Annexure-III**.
- (f): MoFPI does not set up food processing units on its own. It is incentivizing establishment of such facilities through its schemes of PMKSY, PMFME and PLIS, which are demand driven in nature and implemented across the country.
