PNG City Distribution Network in Madhya Pradesh

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has extended Piped Natural Gas (PNG) city distribution network in the State of Madhya Pradesh;
- (b) if so, whether this facility of Piped Natural Gas (PNG) has also been provided to the domestic and industrial consumers of the city of Panna, Katni and Chhatarpur of the Khajuraho Lok Sabha Constituency;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor and also the details of efforts or proposal, if any, being made in this regard?

(a) to (d): Providing Piped Natural Gas (PNG) connections and establishment of Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) stations are part of the development of City Gas Distribution (CGD) Network and the same is being carried out by the entities authorised by Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB). PNGRB has authorized 307 Geographical Areas (GAs) covering almost 100% of total geographical area of the country spread over around 733 districts in 34 states/UTs. In Madhya Pradesh, PNGRB has authorized 25 GAs, including 5 GAs that extend into the neighboring states of Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, and Rajasthan. The cities of Panna, Katni, and Chhatarpur in the Khajuraho Lok Sabha constituency fall under two separate GAs. These, along with other GAs, cover the entire state of Madhya Pradesh. The entities are mandated to provide 59.71 lakh PNG(D) connections by 2030 in the state of Madhya Pradesh.
