- (a) the current status of National Highway (NH)-727 project;**
- (b) the time by which it is likely to be completed; and**
- (c) the steps taken for timely completion of the said project?**

**(a) to (c) NH 727 starts from its junction with NH-27 near Kushinagar in the State of Uttar Pradesh connecting Bagaha, Bettaih and terminates at its junction with NH-527D near Chhapwa in the State of Bihar. In the State of Bihar, 97 km length has been developed to 2 lane paved shoulder standards and balance 13km length passing through Valmiki Tiger Reserve has deficient carriageway and pavement standards.**

**Length of NH-727 in the State of Uttar Pradesh is about 58 km (design length). Ministry has sanctioned work for upgradation to 4-laning/2-laning with paved shoulder works for 46.5 km including Kasya bypass & Padrauna Bypass and one time improvement work on existing alignment passing through Kasya & Padrauna and balance 12 km length. The work is scheduled for completion by October, 2027.**
