COMMERCIALLY OPERATIONAL AIRPORTS

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION नागर विमानन मंत्री

be pleased to state:-

- (a) the details of the airports made operational for commercial purposes in Maharashtra during the last three years apart from Mumbai, Pune and Nagpur; (b) whether due connectivity has been provided to such airports with mega cities and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to set up more airports which would be commercially operational for the benefit of passengers in Maharashtra; and (d) if so, the details thereof along with the timeline fixed in this regard?

ANSWER

(a): During the last three years, Sindhudurg and Gondia Airports have been operationalised in Maharashtra.

(b): The routes linking Sindhudurg with Mumbai, Hyderabad, and Bengaluru have been made operational under the Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS) - UDAN. Gondia Airport has scheduled airline operations connecting it with Shamshabad. (c) & (d): Ministry of Civil Aviation (MoCA) has granted "In-Principle" approval to City and Industrial Development Corporation of Maharashtra Limited (CIDCO), Government of Maharashtra (GoM), for the development of Greenfield International Airport at Navi Mumbai, Maharashtra. The probable date of completion of the project is by December, 2024.
