**(a): Yes, there has been a steady increase in use of Shamshabad airport, Hyderabad. The Shamshabad airport had handled 8.7 million total passengers during 2013-14 which has increased to 25.0 million during 2023-24 witnessing a Compounded Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) of 11%.;**
