Upgradation of AYUSH Hospitals

3002 Smt. Poonamben Hematbhai Maadam:

Will the Minister of AYUSH be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has sanctioned funds for the upgradation of AYUSH hospitals under the National Ayush Mission in the country; and
- (b) if so, the details of the total funds released and utilised for the upgradation of AYUSH hospitals during the last three years, State/UT wise?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) Public Health being a State subject, upgradation of AYUSH hospitals in the country, comes under the purview of respective State/UT Governments. However, under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM), there is a provision of financial assistance to States/UTs for upgradation of Government standalone Ayush Hospitals for which State/UT Governments are required to submit proposals through their State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) as per the provision of NAM guideline to avail grants. Under NAM, as per the proposals received from the State/UT Governments through SAAPs, the State/UT-wise details of funds released for upgradation of AYUSH hospitals and expenditure reported by the State/UT Governments during the last three years is furnished at **Annexure**.
