Will the Minister of AYUSH be pleased to state:

(a) the manner in which the National AYUSH Mission is implemented by the Government;

(b) the number of AYUSH hospitals and new AYUSH colleges set up in the State of Bihar under the said Mission;

(c) the present status of progress in respect of the proposed AYUSH hospital in Darbhanga district of Bihar;

(d) whether a new AYUSH college in Darbhanga district of Bihar is proposed to be set up; and

(e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (I/C) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYUSH (SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

(a) Ministry of Ayush is implementing the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM) through State/UT Governments and providing financial assistance to them for development and promotion of Ayush system in the country under different activities against their proposals received through State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) as per the provisions of NAM guidelines.

(b) to (e) Public Health being a State subject, setting up of AYUSH hospitals & AYUSH colleges in the States/UTs including Bihar comes under the purview of respective State/UT Government. However, under NAM, there are provisions of financial assistance to the State/UT Governments for the establishment of new 50/30/10 bedded Integrated Ayush Hospital and new Ayush college in the States where availability of Ayush teaching institutions

is inadequate in Government sector, for which they have to submit suitable proposals through SAAPs as per provisions of NAM guidelines.

As per the proposals received from the State Government of Bihar through SAAPs, Ministry of Ayush has supported 4 units of 50 bedded Integrated Ayush Hospital at Patna, Darbhanga, Khagaria, & Gopalganj Districts. As reported by the State Government, a letter has been issued to Bihar Medical Services and Infrastructure Corporation Limited (BMSICL) to prepare the Detailed Project Report (DPR) of 50 Bedded Integrated Ayush Hospital at Darbhanga. Further, under NAM, no proposal has been received from the State Government of Bihar through SAAPs for setting up of new Ayush college in Darbhanga District.
