(a) to (c): Government of India is committed to provide good quality health care services through increasing access, increasing affordability by lowering the cost of healthcare delivery and equity through Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. The same are inter-alia also reflected in the National Health Policy (NHP) 2017. To achieve the objectives and goals of NHP 2017, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India is implementing large number of Healthcare Schemes/Programmes. The progress of the Schemes/Programmes are regularly reviewed to ensure that the Schemes/Programmes are being implemented as per the objective and in more effective manner.

The Ministry, as such, does not have 100 days based Schemes/Programmes.
