**3137.** Shri Ravindra Shukla Alias Ravi Kishan: Will the Minister of **AYUSH** be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government proposes to start Ayurvedic Nursing Degree course as an add-on of Allopathy Nursing Programme;

- (b) if so, the details thereof indicating the guidelines, duration and syllabus regarding the said course;
- (c) whether the currently working Allopathy nurses are eligible to enroll for the said Ayurvedic Nursing Degree; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

### ANSWER

# THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) MINISTERY OF AYUSH (SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

(a) & (b) The Indian Nursing Council (INC) has notified the Post Basic Diploma in Ayurveda Nursing-Residency Programme as an add-on of Allopathic Nursing Programme under the INC Act, 1947 vide Gazette notification dated 22.02.2023 namely, Indian Nursing Council (Post Basic Diploma in Ayurveda Nursing-Residency Programme) Regulations 2022. The duration of the course is one year and its curriculum is conceptualised encompassing major speciality courses for speciality nursing practice. (c) & (d) Any Registered Nurse (GNM/B.Sc(N)) and registered midwife is eligible to apply for the Post Basic Diploma in Ayurveda Nursing-Residency Program. The diploma will be awarded by respective examination board/SNRC (Staff Nurse and Midwives Registration Council)/University approved by the Indian Nursing Council.
