**ONE STOP CENTRE IN CHHATTISGARH**

3169. SHRI BRIJMOHAN AGRAWAL:

Will the Minister of Women and Child Development pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is implementing One Stop Centres (OSCs) scheme under the National Mission for Empowerment of Women to provide integrated support and assistance under one roof to the women affected by violence in Chhattisgarh;
- (b) if so, the details of OSCs set up and operationalized in Chhattisgarh particularly in Raipur and other districts;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the number of distressed women who have been provided assistance during the last three years in the said districts?

**ANSWER**

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT  
(SHRIMATI ANNPURNA DEVI)

(a): The One Stop Centre (OSC) scheme is being implemented by the Government across the country since 1st April, 2015 to provide integrated support and assistance under one roof to women affected by violence and those in distress, both in private and public spaces. It also provides an integrated range of services including medical aid, legal aid and advice, temporary shelter, police assistance, psycho-social counselling to needy women. So far, 816 One Stop Centres have been approved in all 36 States/UTs, out of which 786 OSCs are operational including in Chhattisgarh.

(b) and (c): The Ministry has approved 34 One Stop Centres (OSCs) with one OSC in each of the 33 districts and one additional OSC Raipur district of State of Chhattisgarh. Out of these 34 approved OSCs, 27 OSCs are operational as on date. The details of these OSCs are at **annexure-I**.

(d): The details of district-wise number of women assisted through the OSCs during the period from 2021-22 to 2023-24 are placed at **annexure-II**.
