3170. SHRI MADDILA GURUMOORTHY:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state: पत्तन, पोत परिवहन और जलमार्ग मंत्री

(a) whether Government has formulated any action plan for the development of interwaterways in the rivers of the country;

(b) if so, the details of the rivers and the waterways included in the action plan, Statewise including Andhra Pradesh;

(c) if not, the reasons therefor;

(d) whether there is any specific plan for Andhra Pradesh in this regard; and

(e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

(a)& (b) Yes. For development of Inland Water Transport (IWT) in the country, 111 waterways (including 5 existing and 106 new) spread over 24 states have been declared National Waterways (NWs) under the National Waterways Act, 2016. Action plan has been formulated for development of 26 viable NWs based upon the outcome of study reports. The State-wise details of rivers and waterways included in the action plan (including the State of Andhra Pradesh) are at Annex.-1.

(d) & (e) Yes. The details of developmental works undertaken in Andhra Pradesh are given in Annex.-2

2	4 floating pontoons procured and handed over to the Andhra Pradesh Tourism Development Corporation.
3	The land acquisition for Ro-Ro terminals at Harischandrapuram and Muktyala are completed and land acquisition process for Ro-Ro terminal at Ibrahimpatnam has been initiated.
4	Regular hydrographic survey between Vijayawada – Muktyala stretch of NW-4.
5	Rs.15 crore allocated for developmental works on NW-4.
