NATIONAL MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAMME IN THE NORTH EASTERN REGION (NER)

3194. SHRI PRADYUT BORDOLOI:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of districts in the North Eastern Region (NER) that are covered under the District Mental Health Programme, State/UT/district-wise;
- (b) the total number of operational psychiatric hospitals, mental health professionals and recent modernization efforts of Government-run mental hospitals under the National Mental Health Programme (NMHP);
- (c) the total amount of funds allocated to districts in the NER under the NMHP and utilisation rates for the same; and
- (d) the total number of students trained at Lokopriya Gopinath Bordoloi Regional Institute of Mental Health, Tezpur, Assam and any of its programmes since its inception, year-wise?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SH. PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

(a) to (d) The State-wise list of 767 districts approved under DMHP, including the districts in the North Eastern Region (NER), is available at https://mohfw.gov.in/sites/default/files/List%20of%20Approved%20DMHP%20Districts_0.pdf. The State-wise list of mental health professionals at DMHP units in the North Eastern Region (NER) is at Annexure-I.

As per the available information, there are 47 Government run mental hospitals in the country, including 3 Central Mental Health Institutions, viz. National Institute of Mental Health and Neuro Sciences, Bengaluru, Lokopriya Gopinath Bordoloi Regional Institute of Mental Health, Tezpur, Assam and Central Institute of Psychiatry, Ranchi.

Under the tertiary care component of National Mental Health Programme, 25 Centres of Excellence have been sanctioned to increase the intake of students in PG departments in mental health specialities as well as to provide tertiary level treatment facilities. Further, the Government has also supported 19 Government medical colleges/institutions to strengthen 47 PG Departments in mental health specialties. Mental Health Services are also provisioned for in 22 new All India Institute Of Medical Science (AIIMS).

The Government is also augmenting the availability of manpower to deliver mental healthcare services in the underserved areas of the country by providing online training courses to various categories of general healthcare medical and para medical professionals through the Digital Academies, since 2018, established at the three Central Mental Health Institutes namely National Institute of Mental Health and Neuro Sciences, Bengaluru, Lokopriya Gopinath Bordoloi Regional Institute of Mental Health, Tezpur, Assam, and Central Institute of Psychiatry, Ranchi.

The State/UT-wise (North Eastern Region (NER)) details of funds approved for implementation of the District Mental Health Programme (DMHP) component of the NMHP under the National Health Mission for the financial year 2023-24 is at Annexure-II.

The total number of students trained at Lokopriya Gopinath Bordoloi Regional Institute of Mental Health, Tezpur, Assam and any of its programmes since its inception, year-wise is at Annexure-III.
