Will the **Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the funds sanctioned/allocated and utilized for conversion of District/Referral Hospitals into Medical Colleges in Tamil Nadu during the last three years and the current year along with the target set and achievements made so far;
- (b) whether the Government has sanctioned some more colleges within Tamil Nadu under new phase of National Health Mission (NHM); and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

(a) to (c): The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare administers a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for 'Establishment of new medical colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals' with preference to underserved areas and aspirational districts, where there is no existing Government or private medical college. The fund sharing mechanism between the Centre and State Governments is in the ratio of 90:10 for North Eastern and Special Category States, and 60:40 for others. Under the Scheme, all the envisaged 157 Government medical colleges have already been approved in three phases incluiding 11 medical colleges in Tamil Nadu. Entire Central Share has been released to the State government and all the eleven medical colleges have become functional. College-wise details of funds released to the State of Tamil Nadu under the scheme during last three years and current year are attached at annexure.
