Our multi-faceted ties with these countries have continued to strengthen in all areas of cooperation, including political, economic, energy, security, culture and people-to-people ties. Gulf countries are major trade and investment partners for India, and we also have a strong energy partnership with these countries. A large number of Indians reside in Gulf countries.

(d) Along with the need for restraint and immediate humanitarian support, India emphasizes peaceful resolution of conflicts through dialogue and diplomacy.
