(a) and (b) Amount credited on account of cancellation of tickets by passengers is not maintained separately.

(c) No information on this account is maintained. Of the total number of Coaches being presently utilized for running of train services, two-third are non-AC, and one-third are AC variants. Additionally, Indian Railways has also started operating Amrit Bharat services which are fully non-AC trains providing high quality services to the passengers. Keeping in view increased demand, IR has planned to manufacture 10,000 non-AC Coaches including General Class and Sleeper Class Coaches.
