CNG PUMPS IN JHARKHAND

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of CNG pumps opened in Jharkhand, including Hazaribagh and other districts;
- (b) the details of the number of CNG pumps likely to be opened in Hazaribagh in the coming years;
- (c) whether CNG operated vehicles have become more attractive among people in Jharkhand and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the details of the work carried out by the Government in Ranchi under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) during the last three years?

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI SURESH GOPI)

- (a) & (b) Establishment of Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) stations is part of the development of City Gas Distribution (CGD) network and the same is carried out by the entities authorised by Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB). The authorised entities develop the CNG infrastructure in their respective Geographical Areas (GAs) as per their Minimum Work Plan (MWP) and techno-commercial feasibility. PNGRB has authorized 11 GAs (including 3 GAs spread over Bihar and Jharkhand) covering entire state of Jharkhand for development of CGD network. As per MWP, authorised entities have committed to establish 377 CNG stations in the state of Jharkhand, including Haziribagh over the next 8-10 years. As on 31.05.2024, the entities have been given the pro-rata MWP target of establishing 53 CNG stations, However, the entities have established 117 CNG stations in the state of Jharkhand. GA-wise details of CNG stations in the state of Jharkhand is at **Annexure-**I
- (c) Yes, total sales of CNG vehicles has increased over the past few years. As per Vahan dashboard maintained by Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, the total number of vehicles using CNG registered till 22.07.2024 were 72,10,391 across the country including 23,886 CNG vehicles in the state of Jharkhand.
- (d) Details of work carried out by Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) under the administrative control of Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas in Ranchi under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) during last three years is at **Annexure-II**
