(a) The Ministry is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs). As Gram Balwa- Jewra Pulia-Simbhalka stretch is not on NH, details of accident prone black spots or accident prone areas on the said road are not maintained in the Ministry.

The details of accident prone black spots identified on remaining NHs viz., Panchkula-Ambala-Saharanpur-Haridwar National Highway (NH), Meerut-Haridwar NH, Delhi-Yamunotri NH-709B and near the railway bridge on the NH-709B are as under:
