Har Ghar Jal Yojana

596. SHRI ANAND BHADAURIA:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of fund allocated, released and utilized under Har Ghar Jal Yojana during the last two years, year-wise and State-wise;
- (b) the details of targets and number of households covered under the yojana during the last two years, year-wise and State-wise particularly in the State of Uttar Pradesh, district-wise; and
- (c) the number of households targeted to be covered under the scheme during current financial year, State-wise?

ANSWER

(a) Government of India in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household. The year-wise and State/ UT-wise details of fund allocated, released and utilized under JJM during 2022-23 and 2023-24 is at **Annex-I**.

(b) & (c) At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission in August 2019, 3.23 Crore (17%) rural households were reported to have tap water connections. All the remaining rural households at the time of launch of the Mission were targeted for providing tap water connection. As reported by States/ UTs, 6.07 Crore additional rural households were provided with tap water connections till 2021-22. Further, in 2022-23, nearly 2.33 Crore households and in 2023-24, around 3 Crore households were provided tap water connection. Thus, as on 23.07.2024, around 15 Crore (77.65%) households are reported to have tap water supply in their homes.

State/ UT wise details of targeted/ remaining rural households and households provided with tap water connections till 2021-22, in 2022-23, 2023-24 and in 2024-25 (as on 22.07.2024) are at **Annex-II-A**.

The district status of tap water connection provided under the Mission in rural areas is in public domain and available on JJM dashboard at:

Further, as on 22.07.2024, 11 States/ UTs have become 'Har Ghar Jal' States/ UT i.e. 100% households are having tap water supply and 8 States/ UTs are planning saturation in 2024-25. Details of targeted rural households in 2024-25 are at **Annex-II-B**.
