PROMOTION OF TOURISM IN NORTH EAST

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the funds allocated for promoting tourism in the North East Region from 2019-2024, State-wise;
- (b) the details on website traffic, social media engagement, and tourist inquiries generated by tourism campaigns during the above period;
- (c) the number of Tourist Information Centres in the North East Region, State-wise, and number of tourist inquiries handled by each centers;
- (d) whether the Government conducts any surveys to analyze tourist satisfaction in the region and if so, the details thereof including during the last five years, state-wise and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the number of complaints registered with the Government, regarding safety and service concerns in the North East Region during 2019-2024, State-wise and gender-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI GAJENDRA SINGH SHEKHAWAT)

(a): The Ministry of Tourism provides financial assistance to State Governments/Union Territory Administrations/Central Agencies for promotion and development of tourism related infrastructure, under Domestic Promotion & Publicity including Hospitality (DPPH), Swadesh Darshan, National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD) and Assistance to Central Agencies for Tourism Infrastructure Development Schemes.

Detail of projects sanctioned, fund allocated under the above mentioned schemes in the North East Region is at ANNEXURE.

(b): The Ministry of Tourism promotes tourism destinations and products including those in North Eastern Region on its website and Social Media handles.

- (c): The Ministry of Tourism has four offices located at Guwahati, Assam, Naharlagun, Arunachal Pradesh, Shillong, Meghalaya and Imphal, Manipur. These offices provide tourist information to the visitors at Office, airport counter, events, tourism fairs etc. Providing tourism information is a regular work and Ministry does not maintain data of the enquiries handled by the offices.
- (d) & (e): No such survey has been done. Centralised Public Grievance Redress and Monitoring System (CPGRAMS) under The Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG) is an online platform available to the citizens to lodge their grievances to the public authorities on any subject related to service delivery. The Ministry of Tourism has received a total of 12,408 grievances from 2019 till 14.07.2024.
