602. SHRI RADHAKRISHNA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) the details and present status of development of Kalaburagi Bypass road;
- (b) whether there has been an inordinate delay in allotting a new National Highway (NH) number to the Kalaburagi bypass and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the steps taken for urgent allocation of a new NH number for the Kalaburagi bypass?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

a) to c) Ministry has already constructed a ring road bypassing the Kalaburagi city and cutting across three NHs, namely, NH-150E, NH-150 & NH-50. State Government of Karnataka had also requested to declare the green field alignment of the outer ring road around Kalaburagi as National Highway. The Ministry keeps on receiving proposals from various State Governments/Union Territories (UTs) including from the State Government of Karnataka for declaration / up-gradation of State roads as new National Highways (NHs). The Ministry considers declaration of some State roads as NHs from time to time based on the fulfillment of the criteria for declaration of NHs, requirement of connectivity, inter-se priority and availability of resources.
