**REVIEW OF AMRUT YOJANA**

**NO. 687. SHRI KALYAN BANERJEE:**

**Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government has reviewed the function of Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) and if so, the details thereof along with the thrust areas of AMRUT in terms of sewerage, environment and urban transformation;**
- (b) the details of the number of projects undertaken since 2015;**
- (c) whether more than fifty per cent of the projects are still under tendering or in the development stage after ten years in respect to water and sewerage, mobility and pollution in the targeted 500 cities and if so, the reasons therefor;**
- (d) the details of cities and towns selected under the Mission, State-wise; and**
- (e) the present status of the AMRUT for West Bengal and the details of Annual roadmap for 2024-26?**

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE**  
**MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS**  
**(SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)**

**(a): Yes. Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) was launched on 25 June 2015 in selected 500 cities (485 cities including 15 merged cities) and towns across the country. The Mission focuses on the development of basic urban infrastructure in the sectors of water supply; sewerage and septage management; storm water drainage; non-motorized urban transport and development of green spaces & parks.**

**Under AMRUT, States/ Union Territories (UTs) have been empowered to select, appraise, propose and implement projects. A State Level Technical Committee (SLTC) headed by the Secretary, Urban Development & Housing Department provides technical support to the State High Powered Steering**

**Committee (SHPSC) headed by the Chief Secretary of the State, to approve, monitor and supervise the implementation of the scheme at the State/ UT level. Also, an Apex Committee of Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs (MoHUA) constituted under the ambit of Mission guidelines reviews, monitors & supervises the AMRUT Mission periodically. For assessment and monitoring of work done under AMRUT in the States/ UTs, dedicated Independent Review and Monitoring Agencies (IRMAs) have been setup in all the Mission States/ UTs. Also, in order to fast-track the implementation of AMRUT, the progress is periodically reviewed & monitored through regular video conferences/ webinars/ workshops/ site-visits etc. by MoHUA with the States/ UTs & their ULBs. There is a dedicated AMRUT IT portal for tracking the progress and monitoring of projects provided by the States/ UTs. National Mission Directorate is also providing hand holding support to the States/ UTs and ULBs from time to time to resolve issues and eliminate bottlenecks for timely completion of projects.**

**Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has approved State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) of all the States/UTs amounting to ₹77,640 crore for the entire Mission period including Central Assistance of ₹35,990 crore and state share of ₹41,650 crore. Additional funding beyond the approved SAAP is borne by the state government. As reported by State/UTs on AMRUT portal, till date, States/UTs have grounded projects worth ₹83,345 crore.**

**(b): As reported by State/UTs on the AMRUT portal, States/UTs have grounded 5,996 projects worth ₹83,345 crore under AMRUT. List of States/UTs-wise Projects grounded under AMRUT is attached at ANNEXURE-I.**

(c): No Sir, under AMRUT States/UTs have grounded 5,996 projects worth ₹83,345 crore, of which 5,321 projects have been completed as on date, and works worth around ₹77,691.29 crore have been physically completed and expenditure of ₹71,025 crore has been incurred.

(d): AMRUT mission was launched in 500 selected cities. Over the period, a total of 15 cities/ towns have been merged with other Urban Local Bodies (ULBs). The State/ UT wise number of cities (485 cities/ towns) is at ANNEXURE-II.

(e): Under AMRUT, West Bengal has grounded 473 projects worth ₹4,050.25 Cr and works worth around ₹3,939.95 crore have been physically completed. As reported by the State, the current expenditure on these projects is ₹3,553.97 crore.

To carry forward the objective of universal coverage of water supply from 500 cities to about 4,900 statutory towns, AMRUT 2.0 has been launched on 1<sup>st</sup> October 2021 for a period of 05 years i.e. Financial Year 2021-22 to 2025-26. AMRUT 2.0 will focus on making the cities 'self-reliant' & 'water secure'. Providing universal coverage of sewerage & septage management in 500 AMRUT cities is other major focus of AMRUT 2.0.

Under AMRUT 2.0, in the State of West Bengal, State Water Action Plans (SWAP) have been approved for 388 projects worth ₹10,621.59 crore.
