AYUSH Hospitals & Dispensaries

709 Shri Manish Jaiswal:

Will the Minister of AYUSH be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the number of AYUSH hospitals and dispensaries that are functioning across the State of Jharkhand;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to set up any integrated AYUSH Hospital under the National AYUSH Mission (NAM) in Jharkhand;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the other steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to link healthcare facilities of AYUSH with the mainstream healthcare set-up?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYUSH (SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

- (a) As reported by the State Government of Jharkhand, 01 Ayush Hospital and 267 dispensaries are functional as on date.
- (b) & (c) Public Health being a State subject, setting up of Integrated Ayush Hospitals comes under the purview of respective State/UT Governments including Jharkhand. However, under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM), there is a provision of providing financial assistance to the State/UT Governments for the establishment of 50/30/10 bedded Integrated Ayush Hospitals for which State/UT Governments are required to submit their proposal through State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) as per the provisions of NAM guidelines. As per the proposals received from the State Government of Jharkhand through

SAAPs, Ministry has approved 07 Integrated Ayush Hospitals. The details of approved Integrated Ayush Hospitals in Jharkhand under NAM are furnished at Annexure.

(d) Government of India has adopted a strategy of Co-location of Ayush facilities at Primary Health Centres (PHCs), Community Health Centres (CHCs) and District Hospitals (DHs), thus enabling the choice to the patients for different systems of medicines under a single window. The engagement of Ayush doctors/ paramedics and their training is supported by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare under National Health Mission (NHM), while the support for Ayush infrastructure, equipment/ furniture and medicines are provided by the Ministry of Ayush under NAM as shared responsibilities.
