ECONOMIC SECURITY FOR SMALL SHOPKEEPERS

71. SHRI ARUN BHARTI:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)whether the Government has taken note of the economic security of small shopkeepers;
- (b)if so, the details thereof and the steps taken in this regard;
- (c)whether around three crore small traders/shopkeepers in the country are likely to be benefited from the Pension Scheme for shopkeepers/retail traders and self employed persons and if so, the details thereof; and

(d)the details of small shopkeepers and retail traders covered under the said Pension Scheme in the State of Bihar?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SUSHRI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE)

(a) to (c): The National Pension Scheme for traders was launched in September, 2019. This is a voluntary and contributory pension scheme for providing a monthly minimum assured pension of Rs. 3000/- after attaining the age of 60 years to the traders, shopkeepers and selfemployed persons, and so far 54157 traders have registered.

Criteria	Details
Age	18-40 years
Monthly income/Turnover	Less than Rs.1.5cr turn over for NPS Traders
Monthly Contribution	Rs. 55 to Rs. 200 per month
Exclusion criteria	Member of NPS/ESIC/EPFO
Exclusion criteria	Income Tax Payee

(d): As on 15.07.2024, the number of beneficiaries enrolled in the said Pension Scheme in Bihar are 1,760.
