UPGRADATION OF ANGANWADI CENTRES TO SAKSHAM ANGANWADI

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Anganwadi Centres upgraded into Saksham Anganwadis in Andhra Pradesh, district wise especially Vizianagram and Nandyal during the last three years, indicating the criteria for selection, year wise;
- (b) the list of amenities that will be installed thereunder;
- (c) the funds allocated and utilized for upgradation of these Anganwadi Centres, State wise including the said areas during the last three years, year wise;
- (d) the training and support provided to Anganwadi workers in Andhra Pradesh to enhance their skills and effectiveness in the upgraded Saksham Anganwadi Centres;
- (e) whether the Government has any planned/proposed projects or have fixed any criteria for the upgradation of additional Anganwadi Centres in the said State and Districts under the Saksham Anganwadi and Poshan 2.0 scheme, if so, the details thereof;
- (f) whether there are any delays or challenges faced in the said process, if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (g) whether there is any proposal for welfare of Anganwadi workers in the State of Andhra Pradesh, if so, the details thereof including existing welfare schemes implemented for them?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI ANNPURNA DEVI)

(a) & (b) During the 15th Finance Commission cycle, 2 lakh Anganwadi Centres (AWCs) located in Government buildings @ 40,000 AWCs per year are to be strengthened and upgraded as Saksham Anganwadis for improved nutrition delivery and for Early Childhood Care and Education under Mission Saksham Anganwadi and Poshan 2.0. Saksham Anganwadis are to be provided with better infrastructure than the conventional Anganwadi Centres including internet/Wi-Fi connectivity, LED screens, water purifier/installation of RO Machine, Poshan Vatika, ECCE related books and learning material. District wise details of Anganwadi Centres in the State of

Andhra Pradesh approved for upgradation into Saksham Anganwadi during the last three years are placed at **Annexure I.**

- (c) Details of State wise allocation of fund for upgradation of Anganwadi Centres to Saksham Anganwadi Centres during the last three years, year wise are placed at **Annexure II.**
- (d) Government has launched Poshan Bhi Padhai Bhi (PBPB) initiative on 10th May, 2023 for upskilling of all anganwadi workers across the country to build their capacity to provide early childhood care and education and nutrition service to the children below six years of age. As on June 2024, under Poshan Bhi Padhai Bhi, 11,364 State Level Master Trainers (CDPOs, Supervisors and Additional Resource Persons) have been trained across the Country wherein 376 SLMTs have been trained in 11 Districts of Andhra Pradesh.
- (e) and (f) Under Saksham Anganwadi and Poshan 2.0, for the 15th Finance Commission cycle, two lakh Anganwadi Centres located in Government buildings @ 40,000 AWCs per year are to be strengthened and upgraded for improved nutrition delivery to beneficiaries and for delivery of ECCE to stimulate the creative, social, emotional, cognitive and intellectual development of children under 6 years of age. As on date, Ministry has approved 92108 AWCs for upgradation as Saksham Anganwadis.
- (g) Anganwadi Workers (AWW) and Anganwadi Helpers (AWH) are "honorary workers" from the local community who voluntarily come forward to render their services in the area of child care and development to help the community for which Anganwadi Worker is paid honorarium @Rs.4,500/- per month and Anganwadi Helper is paid honorarium @Rs.2,250/- per month on cost sharing basis between the Centre and State/UT along with performance linked incentive of Rs.250/- per month for AWHs and Rs.500/- to AWWs. In addition, States/UTs are also paying additional monetary incentives/honorarium to these functionaries from their own resources which vary from State to State. The State of Andhra Pradesh provides Rs. 7000/- as additional honorarium to AWWs.

Further, under Mission Saksham Anganwadi and Poshan 2.0, promotional opportunities for Anganwadi Workers have been enhanced across the country including State of Andhra Pradesh. 50% posts of Anganwadi Workers are to be filled by Anganwadi Helpers with at least 5 years of experience and 50% posts of Supervisors are to be filled by promotion of Anganwadi Workers with at least 5 years of experience subject to fulfilment of other criteria.

Insurance benefits have been provided to Anganwadi Workers and Helpers under Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY) for life cover worth Rs.2.00 lakh (covers life risk, death due to any reason) in the age group of 18 to 50 years. Similarly under Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana coverage is provided for accidental cover of Rs.2.00 Lakh (accidental death and permanent full disability) /Rs.1.00 Lakh (partial but permanent disability) to AWWs and AWHs in the age group of 18-59 years. It has been announced in the interim budget FY 2024-25 to extend healthcare annual coverage of Rs. 5 Lakhs under Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) to all Anganwadi workers and helpers.
