**TRAUMA CENTRE NEAR NATIONAL HIGHWAY**

**830: SHRI GIRIDHARI YADAV:**

**Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether many people die in accidents due to the absence of trauma centres near national highways in Bihar;
- (b) if so, the total number of deaths in accidents occurred on national highways in Bihar during the last five years, year-wise;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to set up trauma centres at every 50 kms on all the national highways in Bihar;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the time limit if any fixed therefor; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (e): During 11<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan (2007-2012) and 12<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan (2012-2017) under the “National Programme for Prevention & Management of Trauma and Burn Injuries” (NPPMT&BI), 196 Trauma Care Facilities (TCFs) were sanctioned in Government Hospitals/ Medical Colleges across the country. Many of them are located close to National Highways. Out of 196, 9 TCFs were sanctioned in Bihar and details are as below:

- (i) Civil Hospital, Kishanganj
- (ii) District Hospital, Purnia
- (iii) Civil Hospital, Madhepura
- (iv) Darbhanga Medical College & Hospital, Darbhanga
- (v) S.K. Medical College & Hospital, Muzaffarpur
- (vi) Civil Hospital, Gopalganj
- (vii) Civil Hospital, Jhanjarpur
- (viii) Sadar Hospital, Sasaram, Rohtas
- (ix) AN Magadh Medical College & Hospital, Gaya

Apart from TCFs, 02 burn units have also been sanctioned in Bihar at Patna Medical College and Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College & Hospital, Bhagalpur.

Beyond 12<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan, there is no provision of identification of new trauma care facilities under this scheme.

As per the National Crime Records Bureau, the number of fatalities in accidents occurred on National Highways in Bihar during the last five years from 2018 to 2022 is as below:
