## MALE/FEMALE ENROLLED FOR SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:-

- (a) the total number of youth, male and female separately, who have been enrolled from the States of Chhattisgarh and Rajasthan for skill development training under the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) during the last three years;
- (b) the number of youths in the States, male and female separately, who have got employment or placement after the training during the last three years;
- (c) the total amount of funds allocated and spent for this programme during the last three years;
- (d) whether the Government has proposed to set up Skill Development Training Centres in the backward districts of States of Chhattisgarh and Rajasthan; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

## **ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(a) Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is implementing its flagship scheme Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), since 2015, for imparting skill development training through Short-Term Training (STT) and up-skilling and re-skilling through Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) to youth across the country including Chhattisgarh and Rajasthan.

The details of total candidates, including of male and female candidates, who have been enrolled in the states of Chhattisgarh and Rajasthan under PMKVY during the last three years (2021-22 to 2023-24) are given below:

(b) Placements were tracked in the Short-Term Training (STT) component across the first three versions of the Scheme-PMKVY 1.0, PMKVY 2.0 and PMKVY 3.0-implemented from FY 2015-16 to FY 2021-22. However, in PMKVY 4.0, the current version of the scheme being implemented from FY 2022-23 onwards, placement is delinked. The details of the total candidates, including the number of male and female candidates, who have been reported placed in the states of Chhattisgarh and Rajasthan under PMKVY during the last three years (2021-22 to 2023-24) are given below:

(c) Under PMKVY 2.0 and 3.0, there were two components: Centrally Sponsored Centrally Managed (CSCM) component, implemented through the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), and Centrally Sponsored State Managed (CSSM) component, implemented through the States/State Skill Development Missions (SSDM). In the CSCM component of PMKVY, there was no provision for state-wise fund allocation. However, under the CSSM component, funds were allocated to the States/UTs. The PMKVY 4.0 scheme is being implemented as a Central Sector Scheme. The amount of fund utilized under CSCM Component and fund released and utilized under CSSM Component of PMKVY during the last three year (2021-22 to 2023-24) to the States of Chhattisgarh and Rajasthan is given below:

<sup>\*</sup> During the last three year, funds have not been released to the States of Chhattisgarh and Rajasthan under the State Component (CSSM). Under PMKVY 3.0, there was a provision of carry-forward of unspent funds of PMKVY 2.0 to PMKVY 3.0.

(d) & (e) Under PMKVY, training centres are empanelled through the process of accreditation and affiliation through online portal Skill India Digital Hub. Under PMKVY (2.0 to 4.0), as on 30.06.2024, 192 and 225 training centres have been empanelled in the Aspirational Districts of the States of Chhattisgarh and Rajasthan respectively.
