# NUMBER OF STUDENTS IN KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS

## †953 SHRI GANESH SINGH:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- the details of the total number of Kendriya Vidyalayas opened across the country till now, State-wise;
- (b) the number of students studying in these Vidyalayas, State-wise;
- (c) whether opening of a new Kendriya Vidyalaya in newly formed Maihar district of Madhya Pradesh can be considered where large number of Central Government employees live; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

#### ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SHRI JAYANT CHAUDHARY)

(a) & (b) At present, 1253 Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are functioning across the country and as per information received from Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS), 13,36,685 students (as on 30.06.2024) are studying in these Vidyalayas. State/UT-wise details are annexed.

(c) & (d) Opening of new KVs is a continuous process. KVs are opened primarily to cater to the educational needs of the wards of transferable Central Government Employees including Defence & Para-military personnel, Central Autonomous Bodies, Central Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and Central Institute of Higher Learning (IHL) by providing a common programme of education throughout the country. Proposals for opening of new KVs may be sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India / State Governments / Union Territories (UTs) Administrations, with commitment to provide requisite resources including land and temporary accommodation for setting up a new KV as per extant procedures.

As per information received from KVS, a proposal for opening of a new KV at Maihar district of Madhya Pradesh has been received. The proposals received from the sponsoring authorities for opening of new KVs are examined and processed at various levels and are subject to approval of the competent authority, as per extant procedures.
