CENTRALLY SPONSORED EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS IN BIHAR

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the names of the centrally sponsored educational institutions set up in Bihar since the year 2014 along with the details of the courses introduced, the number of students passed out, the number of teaching faculty and non-teaching staff in each of the said institutions;
- (b) the number of the students graduating from each of the said institutions along with the total amount of funds sanctioned and released for overall development of the said institutions;
- (c) whether the Government has not released the total amount of funds sanctioned for the said purpose; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor?

(a) : As per All India Survey on Higher Education Report 2021-22, Ministry of Education has established three (3) centrally funded educational institutions in Bihar since the year 2014, namely, Mahatma Gandhi Central University (MGCU), Motihari, Indian Institute of Management (IIM), Bodh Gaya, Indian Institute of Information Technology (IIIT), Bhagalpur.

In addition to this, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare has established Dr. Rajendra Prasad Central Agricultural University (erstwhile State University) which comes under the purview of Agriculture Ministry by conversion of the existing Rajendra Agricultural University, Pusa, Bihar. These institutions offer UG Level, PG Level, M. Phil and Ph.D. courses in

different subject of science, commerce and humanities. The number of students passed out in year 2024, teaching faculty and non-teaching staff in respect of institutions under purview of Ministry of Education is given below:

(b) to (d): The University Grants Commission (UGC) has informed that a total of Rs.172.75 Crore has been released by UGC to Mahatma Gandhi Central University, Motihari in last five years. For IIM, Bodh Gaya, Rs.543.27 Crore was sanctioned and entire amount has been released. For IIIT, Bhagalpur which is under Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode, the funds are released as per demand/ requirement.
