- (b) whether the Recruitment Rules (RRs) for all the said posts including the post of Director and faculty staff including resident doctors and other para-medical staff have been framed by the Government;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) Data regarding details of posts created for medical colleges under the State Governments is not centrally maintained. Details of sanctioned number of posts in medical colleges/institutes and autonomous medical colleges/institutes under the Central Government is at Annexure-I. These include all categories (Group A/B/C) of posts in these colleges/institutes such as head of the institution, administrative posts, faculty posts, posts of Senior Residents and Junior Residents and non-faculty posts.
- (b) to (d) Framing and amendment of the Recruitment Rules (RRs) is a periodic administrative exercise undertaken by the respective Institutes. Any amendment to the RRs is also made on evolving requirements. RRs for majority of posts in these medical colleges/institutes have been framed.
