Implementation of Welfare Schemes by NABARD for tribals

†*184. **Shri Ravindra Dattaram Waikar and Shri Gyaneshwar Patil:**

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) is implementing any scheme for the welfare of the people of tribal areas across various States in the country;

(b) if so, the details year-wise, particularly in Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and Dadra and Nagar Haveli including Mumbai, Khandwa district and Sambhaji Nagar in Aurangabad during the last three years and the current financial year;

(c) the details of funds allocated for the said schemes and programmes, district-wise, especially for Khandwa district of Madhya Pradesh, Mumbai and Sambhaji Nagar of Maharashtra and Dadra and Nagar Haveli during the aforesaid period along with the benefits derived by the tribal communities from the same; and

(d) the steps taken by NABARD for providing assistance to the backward tribal communities of the country, State-wise and district-wise details thereof, particularly of Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and Dadra and Nagar Haveli including Mumbai, Khandwa district and Sambhaji Nagar in Aurangabad?

(a) to (d): A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

Statement referred in reply to parts (a) to (d) of Lok Sabha Starred Question No. *184 to be answered on 09.12.2024 regarding Implementation of Welfare Schemes by NABARD for tribals by Shri Ravindra Dattaram Waikar and Shri Gyaneshwar Patil :

(a) to (d): NABARD is implementing Tribal Development Programme since 2003-04, under which, projects are funded through Tribal Development Fund (TDF). These projects aim to provide sustainable livelihood opportunities to tribal families across the country. The first project under TDF was sanctioned in the year 2005-06 and since then, 1029 projects have been sanctioned by NABARD, benefitting 6.29 lakh families covering an area of 5.77 lakh acre. Further, approximately 2.9 crore trees have been planted cumulatively through the Tribal Development Programme across India.

The state/UT-wise district-wise details of projects including the state of Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh, sanctioned under TDF during the last three financial years are at **Annexure I**. There is no project sanctioned in Dadra & Nagar Haveli during the aforesaid period.

The benefits accrued through Tribal Development Fund (TDF) across States are as follows:

1. Horticulture development focusing on fruit/plantation/herbal crops and forest plants.
2. Allied agricultural activities such as sericulture, apiculture, animal husbandry, and micro-enterprise development. These activities aim to explore other sources of income generation and establish sustainable livelihood options for tribal families.
3. Plantation of forest species along the boundaries ensures staggered income in the long term.
4. Water resource development and soil conservation are integral parts of the project, aiding climate-resilient agriculture
5. The project emphasizes institution building through the formation of cooperatives and producer organizations. Support is provided for processing and marketing of farm produce.
6. The project adopts a family-based approach to development, emphasizing sustainability as a key factor for success.
7. Women's development is prioritized through initiatives such as reducing drudgery, promoting on-farm and off-farm income generation activities, and facilitating the formation of self-help groups to foster thrift and credit habits.
