*203. SHRI GOPAL JEE THAKUR: SHRI JANARDAN MISHRA:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENTbe pleased to state:

- (a) the details and number of persons employed under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) during the last five years particularly comparing 2014-24 and 2006-13 State/district-wise, particularly in Bihar including Darbhanga, Himachal Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) the details and role of Aadhaar Based Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) for increasing the earning/livelihood of the beneficiaries in the country, State-wise particularly in the said States including Darbhanga and Amroha Parliamentary Constituency; and
- (c) whether the Government proposes to deploy Central Investigation Team to ensure successful implementation of the said schemes and if so, the details thereof?

- (a): Details of person-days generated under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS), State/Union Territories -wise including Bihar, Himachal Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh from the financial years 2006-07 to 2013-14 and 2014-15 to 2024-25 (as on 05.12.2024) are given at Annexure-I. Details of person-days generated in Darbhanga district of Bihar under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS are given at Annexure-II.
- (b): To ensure timely payment of wages to the beneficiaries under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS and to address the issues arising due to frequent change of Bank account numbers by the beneficiaries and subsequent non-updation by the Programme Officers, it was decided to implement Aadhar Payment Bridge System (APBS), which doesn't get affected due to change of bank account. This has been made mandatory with effect from 1st January 2024. Payment of wages through Aadhar Based Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode has positive impact on the livelihood of the beneficiaries as it ensures that benefit reaches the hands of intended beneficiaries without any delay or diversion/leakage.

(c): Mahatma Gandhi NREGS is a demand-driven wage employment Scheme. The implementation responsibility of the scheme is vested the Government of States/UTs. The Ministry comprehensive system of monitoring and review mechanisms for Mahatma Gandhi NREGS. The Ministry regularly reviews the performance of the implementation of the scheme in States/UTs through various means viz., Mid-Term Review, Labour Budget meetings, Labour Budget revision meetings, and programme review meetings. National Level Monitors, Common Review Missions, and officials from the Ministry visit States/UTs at regular intervals to assess the scheme's implementation. Further, Social Audit and Ombudsperson mechanism have also been set up to redress the grievances and ensure implementation of the Scheme as per the provision of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment **Guarantee Act (Mahatma** Gandhi NREGA), 2005. Regarding deployment of the Central Team, it is stated that whenever any complaint is received, based on the seriousness of the issue, Ministry takes appropriate action.
