- (a) the details of the steps taken towards improving the National Career Service Portal; and
- (b) the details of the number of registrations done on the e-Shram portal till date, State/sector-wise, particularly in the Odisha State?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SUSHRI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE)

(a) Improvement of the National Career Service (NCS) Portal is a continuous and dynamic process and is based on suggestions and requirements of stakeholders. So far, the following steps have been taken to improve the portal including integration with Government portals such as Udhyam, e-Shram, Skill India portal, EPFO, ESIC, MHRD, DigiLocker and employment portals of various States; linkages with Government recruitment bodies like Union Public Service Commission, Staff Selection Commission, Agricultural Scientists Recruitment Board, Railway Recruitment Boards etc. for making available scores of non-recommended candidates to other employers to enable them to identify employable candidates. Further, the Ministry has signed partnership agreement with several private job portals for providing opportunity for the job seekers. The Ministry has also approved establishment of 407 Model Career Centres (MCCs) including 7 non-funded in various districts to provide career-related services to jobseekers and employers. In international sphere, NCS facilitates Ministry of External Affairs approved Recruiting Agents (RAs) to post international job opportunities on it to expose domestic jobseekers to global job opportunities.
