CONSTRUCTION OF BYPASS ON NH-168

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to construct a bypass near Reodar and Mandar cities situated on the Deesa-Dhanera National Highway-168A running from Jherda to Sirohi State Highway via Mandar, Reodar (location of the proposed National Highway No.168) which merges into National Highway-62;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the Government proposes to make the Jherda-Mandar-Sirohi road into four lane in order to get rid of the traffic jams observed near the said two densely populated cities and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

(a) to (c) The section of road from Jherda to Panthavada in the State of Gujarat is a State highway and the 10 km section of road connecting Panthavada to Gundari (Gujarat/Rajasthan Border) was notified as NH-168 on 5th September, 2014 but has not been entrusted to the Central Government. State Govt. of Gujarat developed the road connecting Jherda – Panthavada – Gundari

through Build-Operate-Transfer (BOT) Toll mode to 2 Lane configuration with Paved shoulders for which the Concession period is upto 29.03.2038. There is no proposal at this stage to develop the section of NH-168 connecting Panthavada to Gundari (Gujarat/Rajasthan Border) in Gujarat to 4-lane NHs standards.

The stretch of road connecting Gujarat/ Rajasthan Border, Mandar, Revdar to Sirohi of about 76.4 km length (NH-168) is also of 2 Lane configuration with Paved shoulders. State Govt. of Rajasthan developed the road through BOT (Toll) with Concession period upto September, 2024; State Govt. of Rajasthan has handed over this road/ NH to the Ministry recently in October, 2024. Bids have been invited for Consultancy services for conducting feasibility studies for upgradation of Mandar – Sirohi stretch of NH 168 in Rajasthan including bypasses for towns.
