1971: SHRI. ASHOK KUMAR RAWAT:

Will the MINISTER of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of children covered under the Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram since its inception in the State of Uttar Pradesh during the last three years, particularly in the Misrikh Parliamentary Constituency alongwith the funds allocated and utilised during these each year, State-wise and years-wise;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to set up high level laboratories in Central Government hospitals/health centres for early detection of genetic disorders/other diseases through prenatal diagnosis; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with the funds allocated for the said purpose?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

- (a) : As reported by the State of Uttar Pradesh, 6.18 crore children have been screened, 23.43 lakh children have been identified with selected health conditions and 18.21 lakh children have been provided secondary/tertiary care from FY 2021-22 till FY 2023-24 under Rashtriya Bal Swasthaya Karyakram (RBSK).
 - The details of the State/UT wise budget allocation and utilization for RBSK including the State of Uttar Pradesh is placed at Annexure.
- (b) and (c): As reported by the Department of Biotechnology, Unique Methods for Management of Inherited Disorders (UMMID) initiative was started by them to address the burden of genetic disorders in the country. One of the components of the UMMID initiative is establishing NIDAN Kendras (National Inherited Disorders Administration Kendras) for providing clinical care broadly encompassing the activities of prenatal testing for genetic disorders, newborn screening for relatively common treatable genetic metabolic disorders, and genetic counseling of pregnant mothers carrying fetuses with high risk of genetic disorders. Under this initiative, 26 NIDAN Kendras have been established at Government hospitals spread in 15 States/UTs of the country. The total amount allocated for the DBT-UMMID-NIDAN Kendras Initiative is approx. Rs.47.65 Crores.
