### **DEVELOPMENT OF SKILLS FOR RURAL WOMEN**

#### 2171. SHRI SHYAMKUMAR DAULAT BARVE:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps taken by the Government to provide skills to rural women to make them economically self-reliant and enhance their role in various economic activities;
- (b) the number of training centres setup in the State of Maharashtra along with the districtwise details of training efficiently provided to male and female candidates during the last seven years; and
- (c) the number of men and women trained in various fields in Ramtek Parliamentary Constituency along with the area of specialisation they were given training of and number of candidates given placement after the training during the last seven years, year-wise?

#### **ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(SHRI JAYANT CHAUDHARY)

(a) & (b): Under the Government of India's Skill India Mission (SIM), the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) delivers skill, re-skill and up-skill training through an extensive network of skill development centres / institutes etc. under various schemes, viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Sikhshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), to all the sections of the society across the country including rural women. The SIM aims at enabling youth of India to get future ready, equipped with industry relevant skills.

The training under the skill development programmes through various schemes stated above, is provided to all the sections of the society with specific provisions for encouraging participation of rural women. Under PMKVY 4.0 scheme, Skill Hubs and Special Projects actively encourage women's enrollment by ensuring accessibility and providing supportive measures like boarding, lodging and travelling allowances. Training programs in sectors like Electronics, Retail, Healthcare, Beauty & Wellness, Handicrafts and Apparel are structured to attract higher participation from women. Also, projects are designed to align with local skill demands, creating opportunities for rural women to participate and benefit from skill development scheme. Further, there are 324 ITIs & 19 National Skill Training Institutes for women. Under the JSS scheme, focus is being given to women and other vulnerable sections by giving age relaxations and since July 2018, coverage of women beneficiaries under the scheme has been around 82% of the total beneficiaries.

The total number of training centres set up in Maharashtra under major schemes of MSDE is given at Annexure-I. The district-wise candidates (male and female) trained in the State of Maharashtra under major schemes of MSDE are at Annexure-II.

(c): Amongst the schemes of MSDE, placements were tracked under the STT component of PMKVY in the first three versions, which is PMVY1.0, PMKVY 2.0 and PMKVY 3.0 implemented from FY 2015-16 up to FY 2021-22. Under PMKVY 4.0, the focus was to empower our trained candidates to choose their varied career path and they are suitably oriented for the same. Further various IT tools like skill India digital hub also gives this opportunity.
