Setting up of Sports Complex

†2233. SHRI GAJENDRA SINGH PATEL:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government proposes to set up sports complex equipped with all the facilities for the youth in the tribal areas of the country;

(b) if so, the number of sports complex equipped with all the facilities approved for the tribal youth in Khargone-Barwani Parliamentary Constituency along with the time by which these complexes are likely to be ready; and

(c) whether the sports complexes equipped with all the facilities for the tribal youth have not yet been approved for Khargone-Barwani Parliamentary Constituency and if so, the time by which it is likely to be approved?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS & SPORTS { DR. MANSUKH MANDAVIYA}

(a) to (c) 'Sports' being a State subject, the responsibility of development of sports infrastructure, including in the tribal areas of the country, rests primarily with the State/Union Territory Governments. The Union Government supplements their efforts by bridging critical gaps. Further, the Khelo India Scheme is a demand-driven scheme. The proposals received from the State/UT Governments and other eligible entities are considered for financial support, subject to their completeness, technical feasibility and availability of funds under the Scheme. As per the existing guidelines of the Khelo India Scheme, the timeline of completion of infrastructure projects sanctioned under the Scheme is two years from the date of its sanction. The responsibility of executing the projects rests with the grantee.
