NEW OPPORTUNITIES OF EMPLOYMENT

2265. SHRI GANESH SINGH:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of direct or indirect employment available with the Government in respect of new opportunities of employment;
- (b) whether the Government has any data regarding temporary appointment through PSUs of different department besides the Government department;
- (c) if so, the details of such appointment and the number of people got employment every year;
- (d) whether the Government has details of the number of jobs available in the private sector; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (e): Employment generation coupled with improving employability is a priority of Government and is a multi stakeholder initiative and accordingly various Ministries/ Departments of Government of India like Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, Ministry of Rural Development, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Textile, etc. are implementing different employment generation schemes/ programmes. The Ministry of Labour and Employment, Government of India, is implementing the National Career Service (NCS) project for providing a variety of employment related services like job search & matching, career counselling, vocational guidance, information on skill development courses etc. through a digital platform [www.ncs.gov.in]. NCS is a one-stop solution for all career related services including jobs from private and government sectors, information on online & offline job fairs, skill/training programmes etc. As on 15.11.2024, more than 3.52 crore (which inter-alia include the private sector) vacancies have been mobilised on NCS Portal.

The Hon'ble Prime Minister had launched the National Rozgar Mela on 22nd October, 2022. A total of 13 Rozgar melas have so far been held at Central level in 45-50 cities across various States/ Union Territories. As part of Rozgar Mela, the vacant posts in Central Government Ministries and various Organisations of Central Government are being filled up in a mission mode by the respective Ministries/ Departments.

In addition, occurrence and filling up of vacant posts in various Ministries/Departments/PSU/ Railways is a continuous process. Ministries/ Departments of the Central Government have been directed, from time to time, to fill up vacant posts in a time bound manner.

The Employment Linked Incentive (ELI) scheme announced in Budget 2024-25, with an outlay of Rs 1,07,000 Crores, aims at job creation and formalisation of work force by providing Social Security through EPFO, enhancing employability and incentivizing additional employment generation through incentives to employees and employers.

The Public Enterprises Survey, which is conducted by Department of Public Enterprises, Ministry of Finance, provides yearwise number of Regular Employees, Casual / daily Rate workers and Contract Workers/Employees in Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs). As per the data in latest Public Enterprises Survey 2022-23, CPSEs across sectors employed 14.90 lakh persons as of financial year 2022-23.
