(a) the number of sanctioned posts of officers and staff in Delhi Police;

(b) the number of posts along with the designations lying vacant as compared to the sanctioned posts; and

(c) the time by which the appointment on the said posts are likely to be filled?

## ANSWER

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)

(a) to (c) As informed by Delhi Police, out of the sanctioned strength of 94,249 (from Constable to Commissioner of Police), 8,123 posts are vacant in various grades as on 15.11.2024. Occurrence of vacancies, inter-alia, on account of retirement, promotion, and resignation etc. and filling them up is a continuous process. Accordingly, vacancies are reported to the recruiting agencies as per the schedule prescribed in rules. Upon receipt of nominations from recruiting agencies, appointments against vacant posts are made after completion of formalities.
