LIAISON OFFICER TO FILL UP VACANT POSTS RESERVED FOR SCs/STs/OBCs

†257. SHRI DHARMENDRA YADAV:

Will the **PRIME MINISTER** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a Liaision Officer is appointed in each Ministry/Department of the Union Government and subordinate organisations to fill up the vacant posts reserved for Scheduled Castes /Scheduled Tribes/Other Backward Classes to ensure proper compliance of orders and instructions regarding filling up of reserved vacancies and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) if not, the reasons therefor and the names of the Ministries/Departments /Organisations / Public Sector Undertakings in which Liaison Officers have not been appointed to safeguard the interests of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Other Backward Classes; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE (DR. JITENDRA SINGH)

(a) to (c): As per the instructions issued by DoPT, each Ministry/ Department is required to appoint an officer, not below the rank of Deputy Secretary, as Liaison Officer for SC/ST and OBC, in order to ensure compliance of the orders and instructions pertaining to reservation of vacancies in favour of backward classes. All the offices and organizations under the Ministry/ Departments are required to designate a Liaison Officer in the same manner as required in the Ministry/Department to ensure implementation of reservation policies. However, the overall responsibility for implementation of the reservation policy in appointments lies with the Liaison Officer of the administrative Ministry/Department concerned.

As per the information received, all the Ministries/Departments have appointed Liaison Officers for SC/ST/OBC.
